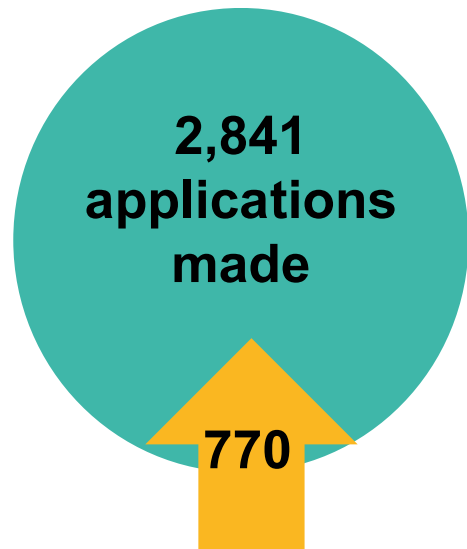

- Continue to build our reputation as the home of volunteering in Gloucestershire through social media, promotional events and outreach activities & materials.



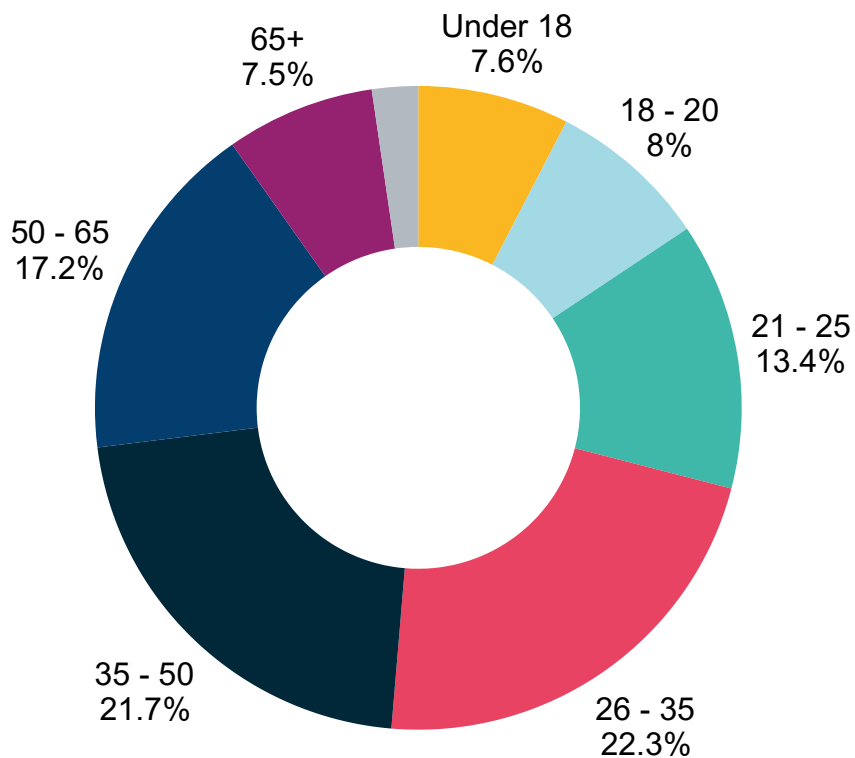
Our Year in Numbers



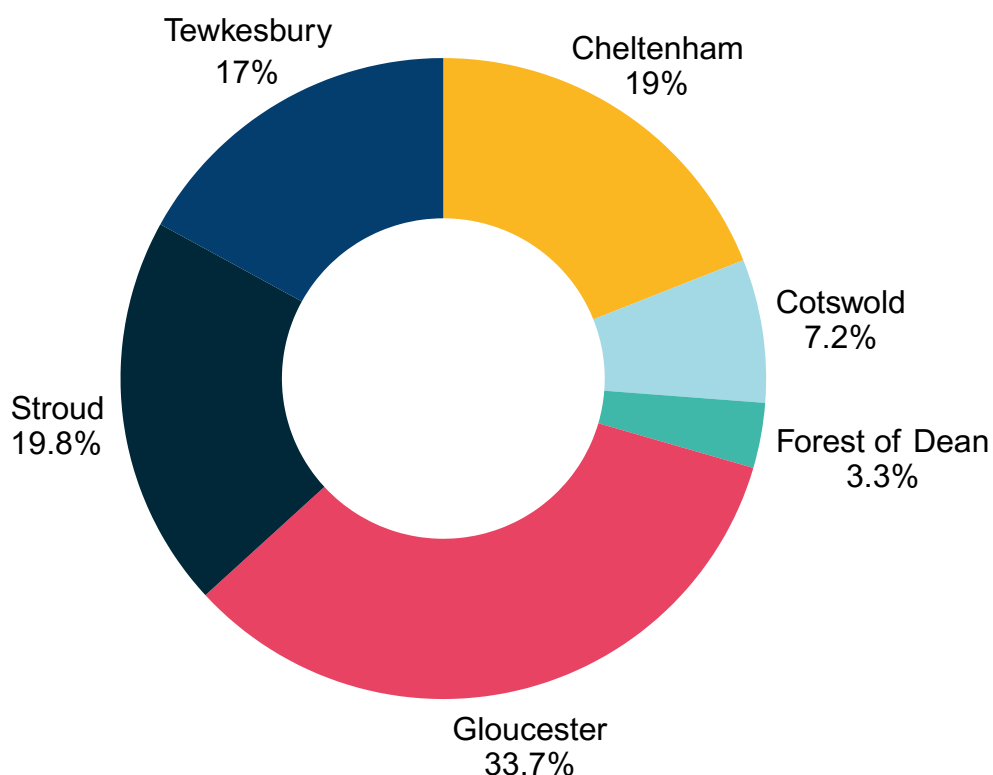

Age brackets of volunteers who applied for roles

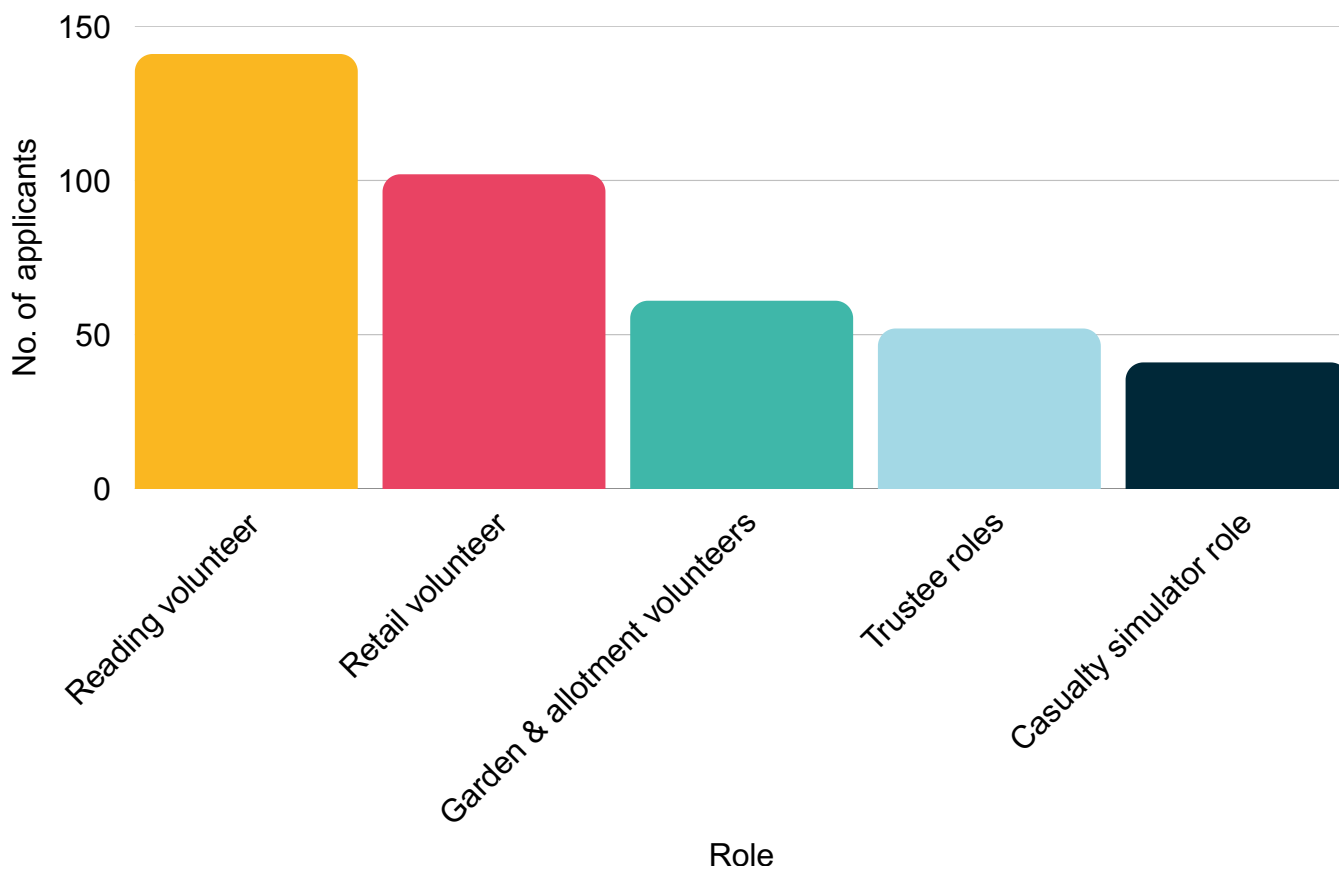


Districts that roles applied for were based in

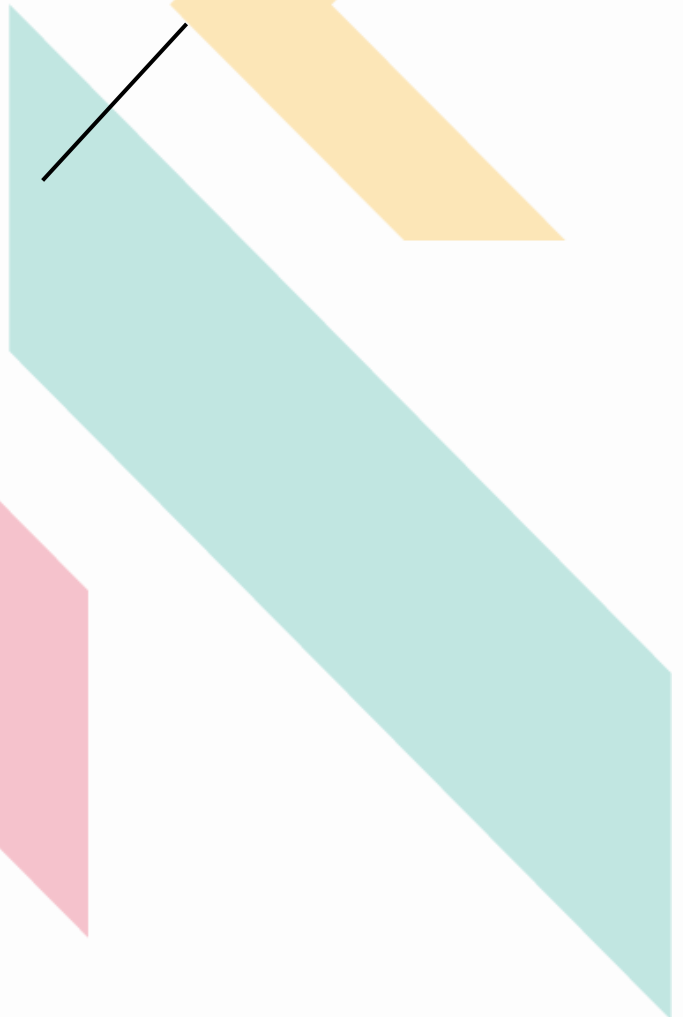


